## CSI Winter Camp Code of Conduct Form

1. LISTEN and DO what the chaperones and coaches ask of you at all times.
2. Remember, you are representing yourself, your home town, and your parents so act like it! Be respectful of bus and hotel property, you will have to pay for any damages yourself.
3. LIGHTS OUT will be strictly enforced at 10:00pm. We will be checking rooms to make sure everyone is in place for the night. You will not be allowed outside your room after lights out.
4. Only fellow campers and family members will be allowed in your rooms.
5. Any long distance calls or pay-per-view movies ordered by anyone in your room will be the sole responsibility of the campers staying in that room. Scott Hayden will not pay for any of these expenses!
6. No girl chasing will be allowed! Remember, we are here for a baseball camp.
7. No possession of Alcohol, Tobacco products, any controlled substance, X-Rated material, fireworks or explosives will be allowed.
8. **The chaperones need to know where everyone is at all times**, therefore, the bus will take us to eat lunch and dinner together as a group. Older campers can request special outings but they must be approved by the chaperones. We will have a check-in/check out procedure for that.

Any violation of the rules will result in your immediate removal from the camp. You will remain in your hotel room, your parents will be required to pick you up and you forfeit your complete camp fees. No misbehavior will be tolerated!
